The West Covina Sabers/Saberettes Youth Basketball Organization is pleased to announce our 2nd Annual Invitational Basketball Tournament. It will be held on July 4th weekend, July 2 - 4, 2010.

Girls and boys divisions will include Kindergarten through 6th grade and a Co-Ed tournament 7th through Prep. Our goal is to give younger teams an opportunity to participate in a basketball tournament. Novice teams and experienced teams alike will be able to test their training and skills through friendly competition.

Kindergarten through 2nd grade teams will receive participation awards; the 3rd grade through 6th division and co-ed divisions will receive placement awards.

The roster form, player waiver, and list of Division Coordinators will be available on the Sabers website at www.westcovinasabers.org. We request that the tournament roster form be filled out electronically.

- Entry fee: \$375.00
- Each team is responsible for providing their own insurance coverage and will be required to sign a liability waiver. Waivers must be submitted prior to the first game.
- Please include a copy of your league roster. For teams not participating in league, submit organizational rosters.
- Non-rostered players must be identified on the roster and subject to approval by the Division Coordinator.
- Rosters may have more than 10 players, but only 10 trophies will be awarded.
- Rules will generally follow CYC and JAO guidelines, and will be sent with the acceptance letter.
- Each team must have a light and dark jersey with permanent numbers (no tape).
- Please send all forms and entry fee payable to **SABERS** to your Division Coordinator. **Entry deadline is May 15, 2010.**
- Roster changes must be submitted before June 1, 2010 and is subject to approval by the Division Coordinator.
